High School Graduate Bachelors Program Scholarship

Scholarship. West Coast Ultrasound Institute's ("WCUI") High School Graduate Bachelors Program Scholarship ("Scholarship" or "Scholarship Program") is awarded to selected applicants and applied toward the cost of tuition. The total amount of the Scholarship to be awarded ("Award") is ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), for education and training in a WCUI Bachelor of Science program. The Award is offered to a limited number of outstanding students who meet the criteria below ("Recipient"). The Award is applied toward the cost of tuition and shall not cover payment of the following items: books, supplies, equipment, uniforms, computers, electronic devices, review courses or registry examinations.

Effective Date: WCUI will accept applications for the High School Graduate Bachelors Program Scholarship after September 1, 2016; therefore, students that graduated from High School after September 1, 2015 will be eligible.

Eligibility Requirements.

- Must submit the Scholarship Application which begins on Page 4;
- Must apply to a Bachelor of Science program at WCUI;
- Must have graduated high school within the past year at the time of application;
- Must meet all admissions criteria as listed in the current WCUI catalog;
- Must have a minimum High School CGPA of 3.0. Sealed and signed transcripts are required; and
- Must be a US citizen or eligible non-citizen and at least 17 years of age.

Application. To be considered for the Scholarship, eligible applicants must submit:

- A Scholarship Application; and
- Two letters of recommendation. Letters of recommendation may be from a prior teacher, coach, employer, or a volunteer organization (not from family members or friends).

Applicants must submit all requested information in order to be considered. Once an application has been submitted, it is final and may not be changed, altered or revised. By submitting an application, the applicant agrees that he/she has read, understood and accepts all the terms and conditions of this Scholarship.

Deadline for Submission. The current scholarship application deadline is 5:00 p.m. PST on the day before the start of classes for the upcoming term to which the scholarship is to be applied.

Selection of Scholarship Recipients. The Recipient will be made from eligible and complete applications (see preceding paragraphs) received within the appropriate application period. WCUI will appoint a panel of judges (Scholarship Committee) to determine the Recipient. All Recipient decisions are final.

Continued Scholarship Eligibility. The Award is pro-rated over each term of enrollment within the Bachelor of Science program the Recipient is enrolled in. The Recipient will lose the prorated scholarship amount for the upcoming term if: (1) Recipient's WCUI CGPA drops below 3.0; (2) Recipient fails to maintain compliance with WCUI's Satisfactory Academic Progress ("SAP") policy as stated in WCUI's catalog; or (3) Recipient is not attending classes full-time. Recipient may again receive the pro-rated scholarship amount for an upcoming term(s) if the aforementioned deficiencies are corrected prior to the start of the term.

Termination or Withdrawal. If the Recipient's enrollment at WCUI terminates before the end of the Program for any reason, any unused portion of the Award shall be forfeited by Recipient. Recipient shall not be eligible to use any remaining portion of the Award and shall be ineligible for any future scholarships from WCUI.

Taxes. Any and all applicable federal, state, and local tax liabilities are the sole responsibility of the Recipient.

Interpretation of Rules/Provisions. WCUI is the sole interpreter of the terms and conditions of this Scholarship Program. By participating, each applicant agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions of this Scholarship Program and that the decisions are final. All entries become the property of WCUI and will not be returned.

General Conditions. This Scholarship Program and any Awards are subject to all federal, state and local laws and regulations and are void where prohibited or restricted by law. WCUI's failure to enforce any term of this Scholarship Program shall not constitute a waiver of that provision. WCUI reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual it finds to be attempting to tamper with or undermine the entry process and/or the legitimate operation of the Scholarship Program; to violate the terms and conditions of this Scholarship Program; or to act in a disruptive manner or with the intent to annoy, abuse, threaten, or harass any other person with respect to the Scholarship Program. WCUI may, in its sole discretion, void any suspect entries. WCUI may modify the Scholarship Program or suspend the Scholarship Program to address any impairment, and then resume the Scholarship Program in a manner that best conforms to the spirit of this Scholarship Program.
